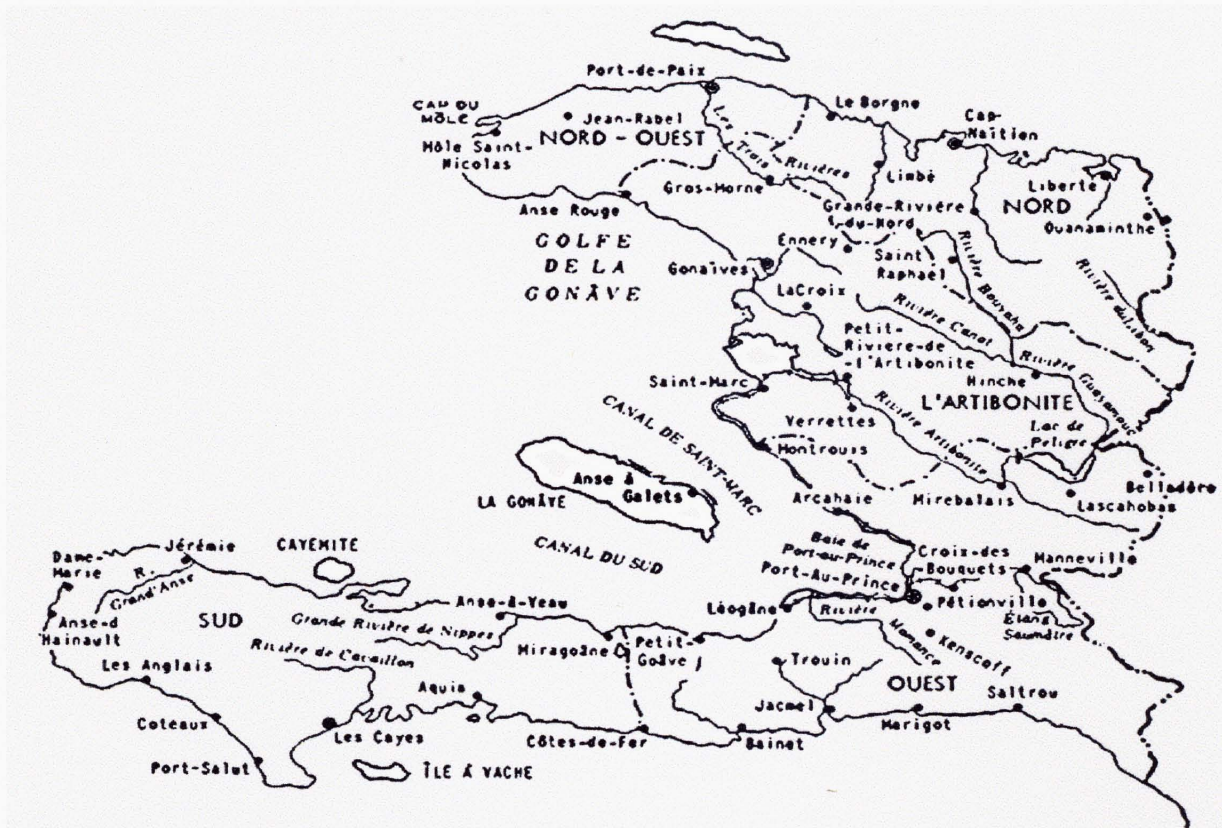


EXOTIC TOWN CANCELS OF HAITI



Exhibited are common stamps with uncommon cancels on and off cover, as well as stampless covers with small town postmarks. The majority of different towns and types of postal markings are represented. Included are covers from one small town to another or to a foreign destination. Excluded are cancels of principal towns such as Port-au-Prince, Cap-Haïtien, Jacmel and Port-de-Paix unless on a cover with a cancel with an exotic point of origin. An exception has been made for the earliest known usage of a Haitian cancel on a Haitian stamp. Mail originating from smaller towns is scarce not only because the population is small and mostly illiterate but also because it was preferred for expediency to post a letter from the nearest large town.

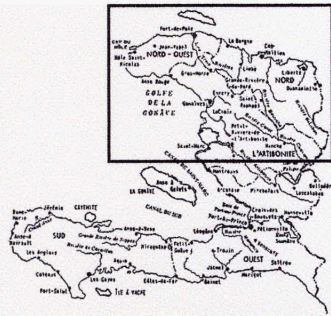

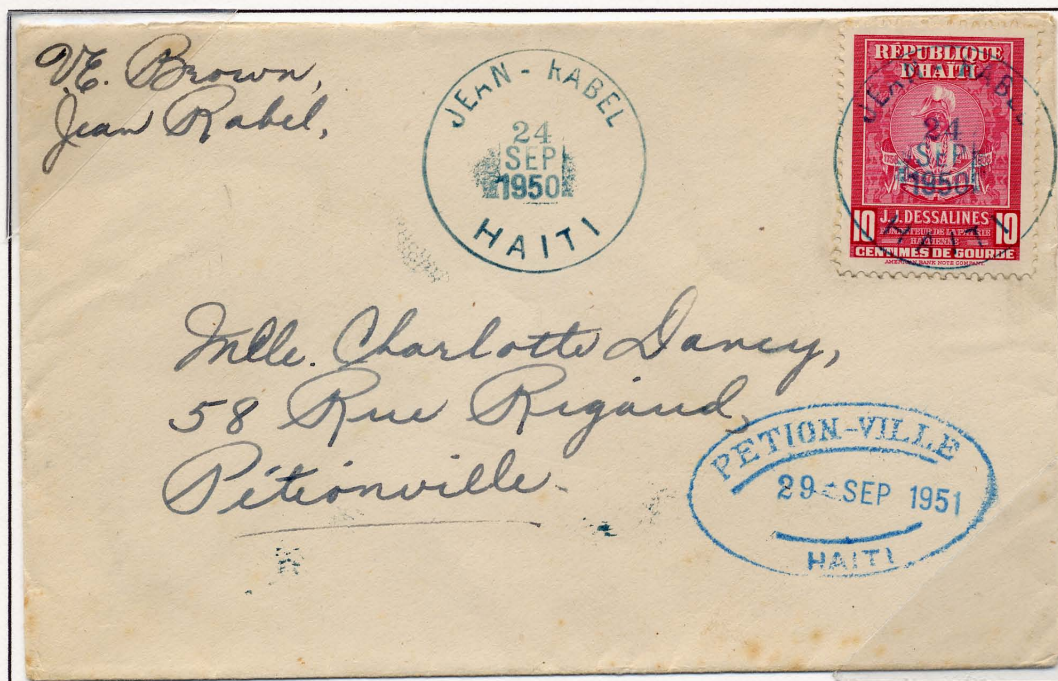

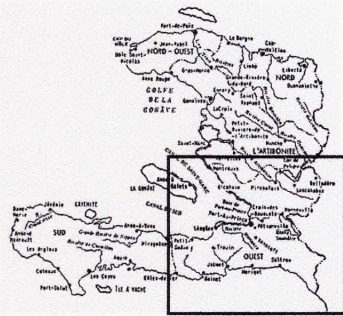

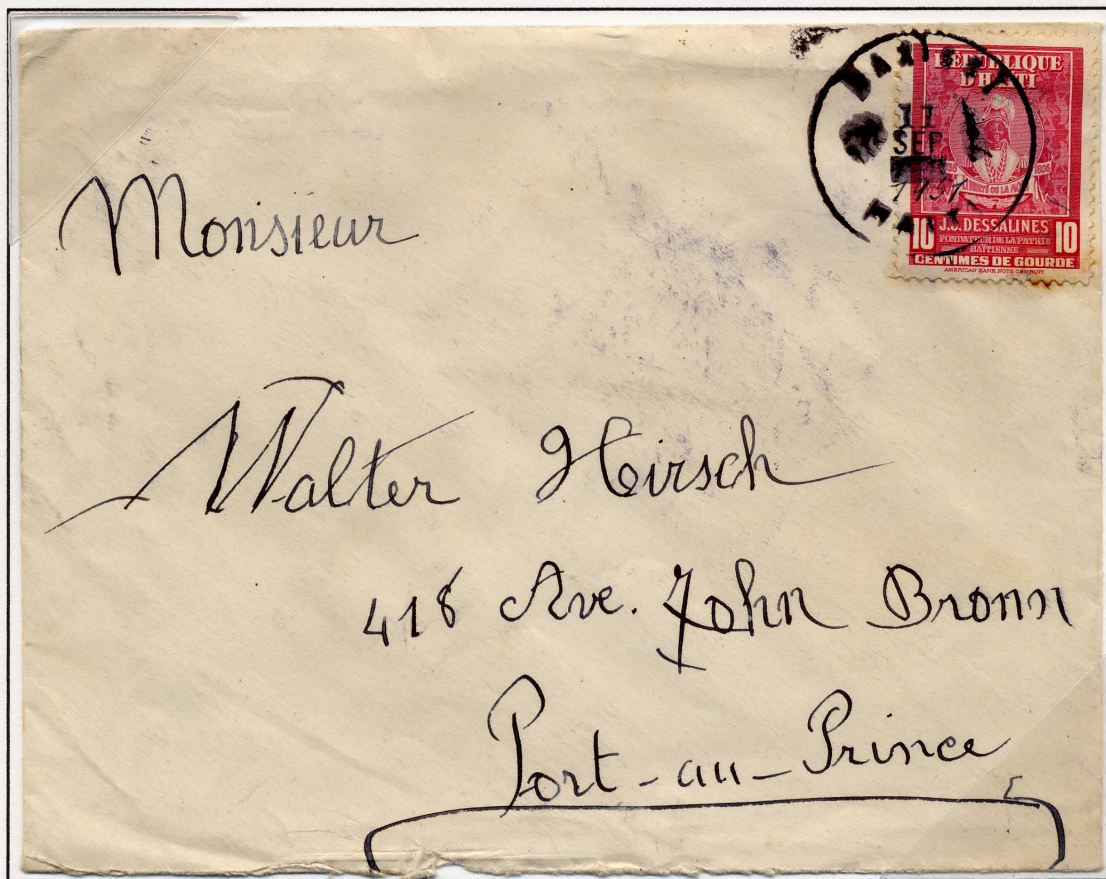

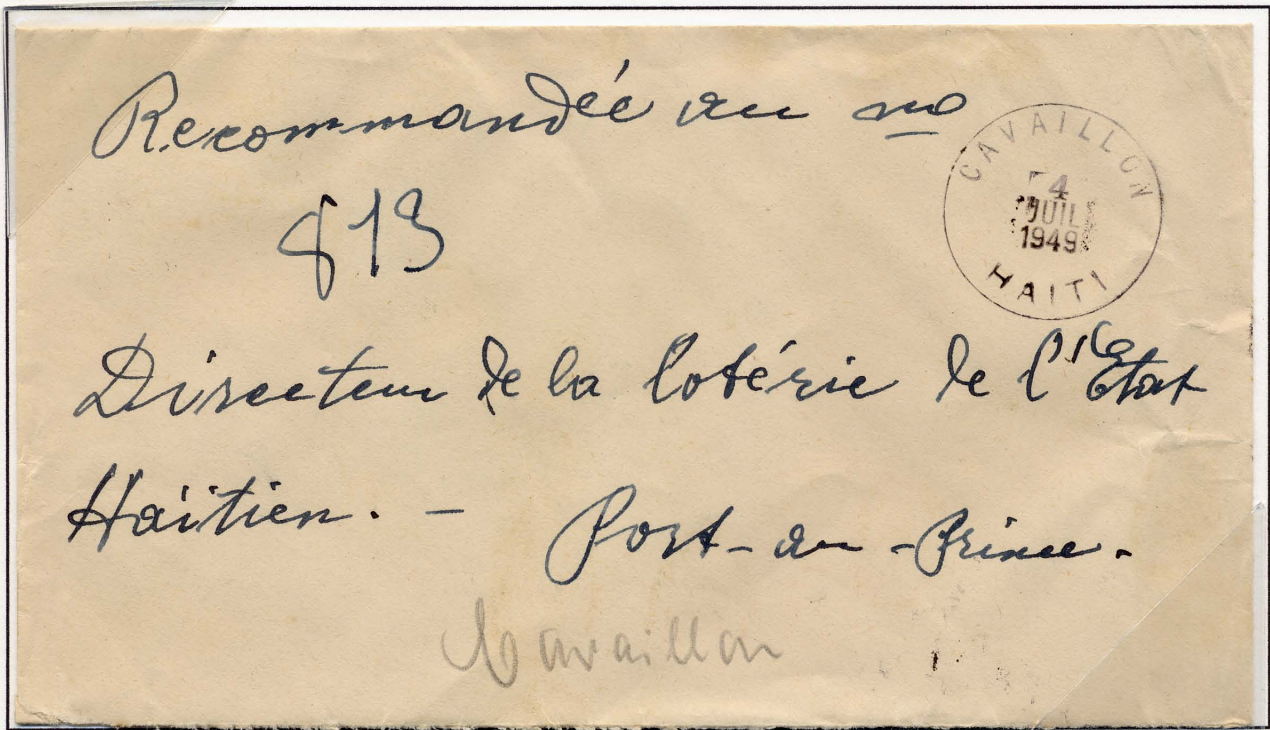

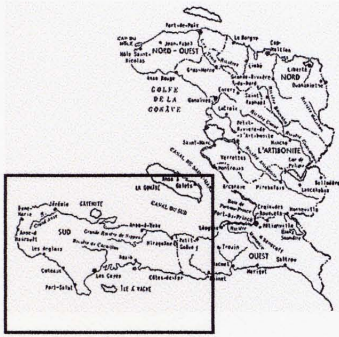

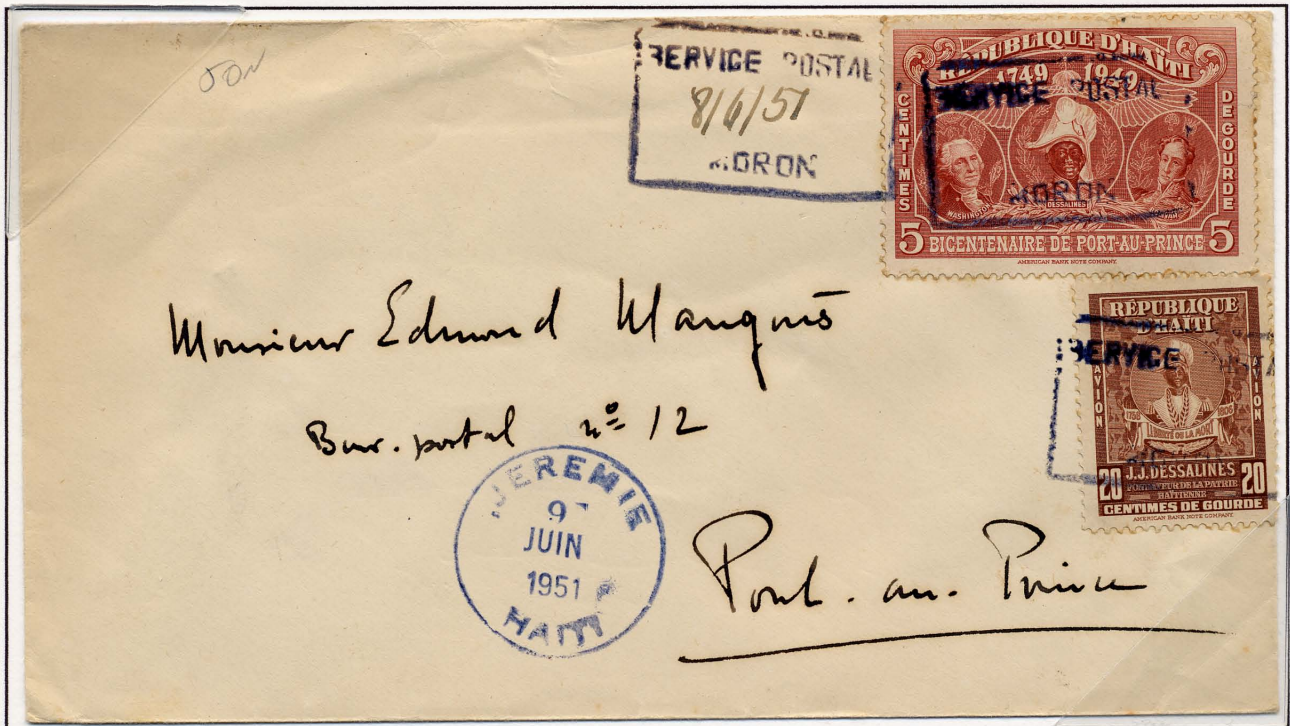
